

Weekly Tasks

In this component of the course, you will be given 10 weekly tasks that must be completed during each of the allotted time (Tuesday lectures, 13:00-14:20, see Course Logistics schedule).

The objective is to complete each task within the (tight) deadline and to demonstrate resourcefulness and “out-of-the-box” thinking.

The tasks are designed to be difficult to complete if you have not prepared beforehand by watching the corresponding videos or read the
